In response to the Public Notice DA 06-8 issued on January 5, 2006 by the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, Motorola Spectrum, Inc. submits the following required information:

Per above, Motorola Spectrum, Inc. currently has no spectrum users.

As reported in previous Annual Reports, Motorola is shipping portable, mobile and base equipment capable of operating in and/or specifically developed for the 700 MHz Guard Bands.

We are encouraged by Congressional passage of DTV transition legislation mandating a 2/17/09 date certain access to the 700 MHz band, and we applaud the FCC for their efforts in promoting clearance of this band. A firm date, though 3 years out, removes many uncertainties of potential spectrum users who may be considering use of this spectrum, especially if they are considering a universal solution across several or many MEA's.

To further promote use of this spectrum, Motorola Spectrum, Inc. entered into an agreement in 2005 with Access Spectrum, LLC for their management of spectrum leases within this MEA.
