

**Rural Digital Opportunity Fund Phase I (Auction 904)
Initially Eligible Locations – Selected Summary**

In accord with the *Rural Digital Opportunity Fund Order*, the Wireline Competition Bureau, in coordination with the Rural Broadband Auctions Task Force and the Office of Economics and Analytics, has released data files containing locations deemed initially eligible for the Rural Digital Opportunity Fund Phase I auction (Auction 904).¹ Data files can be found at www.fcc.gov/auction/904.

The numbers below summarize initial eligibility in states with eligible locations and are based on the eligibility criteria adopted in the *Rural Digital Opportunity Fund Order*, totaling 5,907,896 initially eligible locations. The preliminary location counts are based on census blocks in expensive-to-serve areas that are completely unserved with voice and 25/3 Mbps or higher broadband as of June 2019. These numbers do not represent final Auction 904 eligibility determinations. As indicated in the *Rural Digital Opportunity Fund Order*, the number of locations in each state may be revised in response to the limited challenge process initiated by the *Preliminary Eligible Areas Public Notice* released March 17, 2020.
