Please accept the filing from the Michigan State Police as response to the Federal Communications Commission's request issued pursuant to the NET 911 Act.

The Michigan Emergency 911 Services Enabling Act provides for funding of 911 services in Michigan. Two funding mechanisms, a State of Michigan 911 charge and individual county 911 surcharge, are currently being collected by all communications providers serving Michigan customers on all devices. A fee for prepaid wireless customers is also collected at the retail point of sale. In addition, landline carriers collect a technical surcharge to cover their costs for providing 911 call routing to 911 dispatch centers.
