### Explanation of Effort and Availability of Commercial Equipment

\*Provide an explanation of efforts undertaken, and challenges encountered, in permanently removing, replacing, and disposing of covered communications equipment or service.

No, my company has not conducted work on the removal of covered equipment since the submittal of the last form. The covered equipment that remains in Nemont's network is active and supporting Nemont's customers & roaming partners. It cannot be removed until after the new network is brought online and Nemont's customers are migrated to that network. Nemont anticipates bringing the new network online in October, 2024 and subsequently migrating it's customer during the October-December 2024 timeframe. Once this is done and the new network is confirmed to be stable and supporting our customers and roaming partners, we will begin the removal process. The harsh winters in Montana and North Dakota will impact Nemont's timeline for removing the covered equipment. Typically, tower work cannot be performed from late October through early April, Nemont will begin the removal process as soon as possible but because of the timing, the bulk of the removal and subsequent destruction will happen in the spring of 2025. No, my company has not conducted work on the disposal of covered equipment since the submittal of the last form. Equipment that can be removed, has been removed and stored. This equipment will be destroyed along with the remaining equipment that is still active in the network. Yes, my company has conducted work on the replacement of covered equipment and services since the submittal of the last form. Nemont has completed the installation of the RAN sites it can afford to deploy within the 39% funding allocation. These sites are now being rigorously tested and prepared for live customer traffic once the switching core is completely tested. The switching core is installed, configured and going through rigorous testing. There are a few issues and compatibilities to resolve. We have approximately 100 employees migrated to the new network to assist in resolving these issues. Once they are addressed Nemont will migrate its customers to the new network. We anticipate this happening beginning sometime in October, 2024 and completing in December, 2024. This network will provide significantly less coverage for our customers since the sites deployed are only 70% of the total sites required to provide comparable coverage to that of the covered network.

Timeline deviation: Nemont's completion date was August, 2024. The company applied for and received an extension to complete the project. At least one additional extension will be required to complete the project. Cutover of the portion of the network that can be built with existing funding will be cut over and customers will be migrated to the new network beginning in October 2024 and completing in December 2024. Once this is done and the new network is confirmed to be stable and supporting our customers and roaming partners, we will begin the removal process. The harsh winters in Montana and North Dakota will impact Nemont's timeline for removing the covered equipment. Typically, tower work cannot be performed from late October through early April. Because of the timing, the bulk of the removal and subsequent destruction will happen in the spring of 2025.
