




APE for Direct Effects

Historic Properties for Visual Effects

iv) properties listed in the SHPO/THPO Inventory that the SHPO/THPO has previously evaluated and found to meet the National Register criteria, and that are identified accordingly in the SHPO/THPO Inventory.

 Section VI.D.1.a also requires the Applicant to identify historic properties that have religious or cultural significance to Tribes and Native Hawaiian Organizations.

ii. The SHPO/THPO may also advise the Applicant that previously identified properties on the list no longer qualify for inclusion in the National Register.
