Greetings from the Federal Communications Commission.

Update: Revised Filing Dates for LPFM Window

The Commission is delaying the filing window, originally open November 1—November 8, 2003, for applications for low power FM (LPFM) new station construction permits. The window will now open at 12:01 am EST on December 6, 2023, and close at 6:00 pm EST on December 13, 2023. The filing deadline will be strictly enforced.

The Commission determined that it would serve the public interest to delay the LPFM filing window to afford interested parties sufficient time to prepare applications for new permits.
